About University of Lucknow



The early 20th-century vision and cooperative efforts of influential individuals are reflected in the founding of the University of Lucknow. First proposed by Raja Sir Mohammad Ali Mohammad Khan of Mahmudabad in an article published in "The Pioneer," the notion gained traction with the backing of Lieutenant-Governor of the United Provinces Sir Harcourt Butler. The establishment of a unitary, teaching, and residential university was decided upon by a General Committee that met on November 10, 1919. To handle different elements, six sub-committees were established, and in January 1920, their conclusions were verified.

Major financial assistance was provided by the Rajas of Jahangirabad and Mahmudabad. August 1920 saw the plans approved after Allahabad University assessed them. A bill written by Mr. C.F. de la Fosse was drafted in April 1920, amended, passed in October 1920, and given final assent in November 1920. Using Canning College and King George's Medical College and Hospital, classes started on July 17, 1921, with the University Court being established in March of the same year. Official handovers of these institutions occurred in 1922 and 1921, respectively. This outstanding accomplishment established a platform for future expansion and development and represented a critical turning point in United Provinces higher education.

The University has been accredited with a Cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.55 on a four-point scale at A++ grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council making it the first state university from Uttar Pradesh to get A++ grade which is the top rating any higher education institution in the country can get.
